- 3- To apply methods for conducting qualitative research techniques (such as structured and semi-structured questionnaires, group interviews, and field observations) to ascertain community perceptions of health needs;
- 4- To synthesize and develop effective means of presenting multiple sources of data that describe a community's health resources, health-related problems, and recommendations for action;
- 5- To develop partnerships with community leaders, community based organizations, health providers, and community residents
